A Legend of Gaming Returns!

Mega Man 11, known as Rockman 11: Unmei no Higuruma!! (ロックマン11 運命の歯車!! lit. "Rockman 11: Gears of Fate!!") in Japan, is a new Mega Man game, released on October 2nd, 2018. It is the eleventh main entry from the original Mega Man series.

What's New?

Mega Man 11 features the usual gameplay of the classic Mega Man games, with a new feature. New to the series is the Double Gear System. The system allows Mega Man to possess two new abilities, those being the "Speed Gear" for slowing down time, and the "Power Gear" for Mega Man to charge a more powerful charged shot, shoot two charged shots together, and even power-up his special weapons as previously seen on the announcement and pre-order trailers.[1][2] This is activated by pressing the front shoulder buttons on a controller based on the Gear Position (ex. PS4: B l1 for Power Gear and B r1 for Speed Gear) The Gears have a nasty side effect, though; as a gear is being used, Mega Man starts to overheat as indicated by a gauge above him, which slowly builds up the longer he uses a gear. The gauge can be cooled down by deactivating these gears, but if the gauge reaches maximum, the overheat will prevent Mega Man from using the Double Gear again until after the cooldown has ended. There are also Sprocket pick-ups that help the Double

Gear cool down faster; they come in two sizes, small and large. Mega Man can also switch between either Gear with "Gear Change" by pressing the opposite activation button. When Mega Man is low on health, he can use the Double Gear technique - i.e. activate both gears at the same time - which allows for a devastating Final Charge Shot (though special weapons can still be used) that heavily damages everything onscreen while time is slowed down, but this will leave him severely weakened afterwards until the cooldown period is over which is longer than normal, and it cannot be turned off once activated.[1] There are also several parts sold at the store that can help improve the Double Gear's abilities.

A Familiar Foe

Doctor Wily is back and has some new tricks up his sleeve. His "**Double Gear System**" turns his robots from average performing mechnaloids into nigh-unstoppable war machines. Megaman's own abilities alone will not be enough to stop this dastardly scientist. So, Dr. Light has implemented the Double Gear System into his systems in order to match the power of his old friend. Will this be enough for Megaman to stop Wily?

UNDERTALE IS OUT ON THE NINTENDO SWITCH!

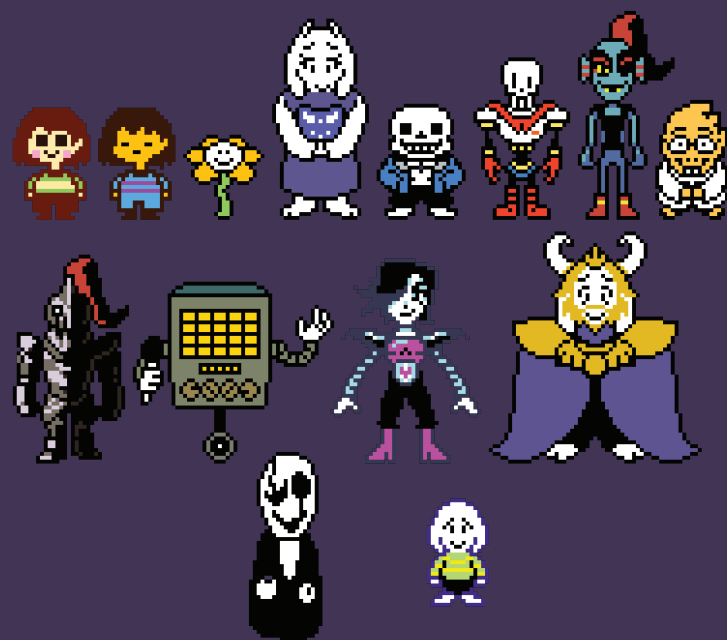
The legendary hit "Undertale" by Toby Fox is finally making its way back to the Surface!

Back in September 15, 2015, a legend was born: a game that would appeal to the masses and start a revolution; one that would quickly amass a large fanbase devoted to the point of a cult frenzy.

Undertale is a role-playing video game created by American indie developer Toby Fox. In the game, players control a human child who has fallen into the Underground, a large, secluded region underneath the surface of the Earth, separated by a magic barrier. The player meets various monsters during a quest to return to the surface, mainly through the combat system; the player navigates through mini-bullet hell attacks by the opponent, and can opt to pacify or subdue monsters in order to spare them instead of murdering them. These choices affect the game, with the dialogue, characters, and story changing based on outcomes (taken from Wikipedia).

The gameplay and battle mechanics (inspired by common RPG games and the Touhou Project), as well as the lovable characters and the intricate story have attracted at the very least 1.3 million people across the world.

Since celebrating its 3rd anniversary, the popular game has finally amassed enough resources to launch a long awaited release on the Nintendo Switch. Already, there have been many positive reviews.



Season 6 Has Arrived!

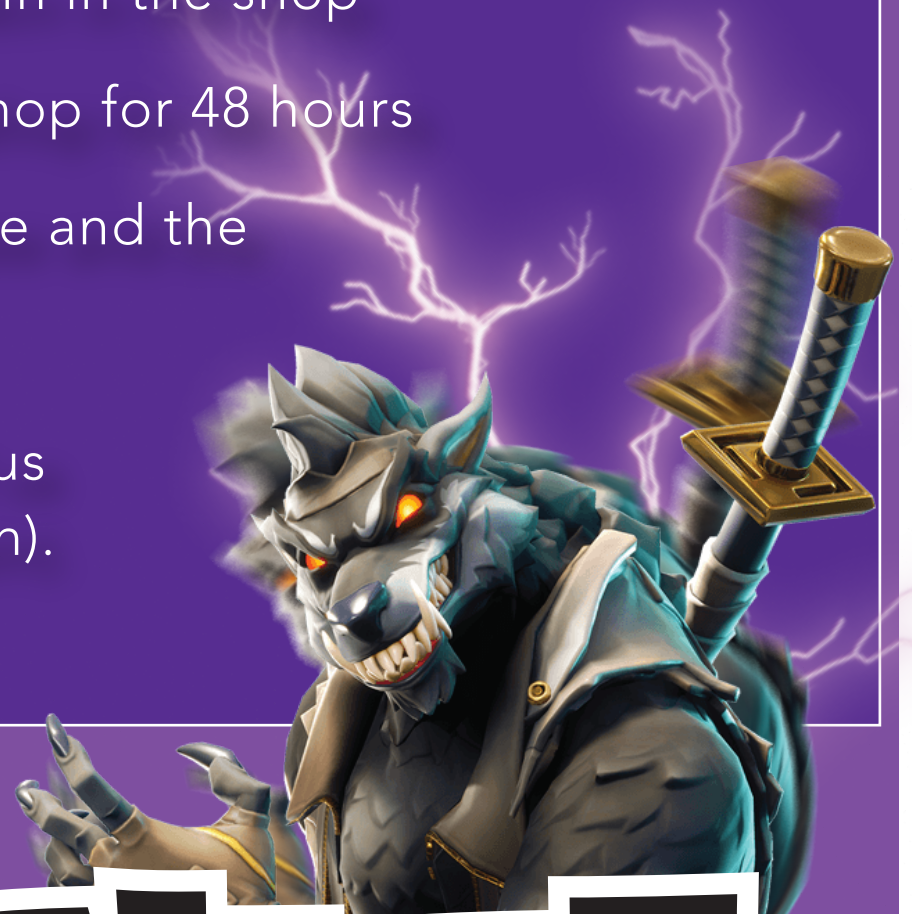
The darkness rises beside player excitement!

FORMULA ONE

ABOUT F1

Formula One (also Formula 1 or F1) is the highest class of single-seater auto racing sanctioned by the Fédération Internationale de l'Automobile (FIA) and owned by the Formula One Group. The FIA Formula One World Championship has been one of the premier forms of racing around the world since its inaugural season in 1950. The "formula" in the name refers to the set of rules to which all participants' cars must conform. A Formula One season consists of a series of races, known as Grands Prix (French for "grand prizes" or "great prizes"), which are held worldwide on purpose-built circuits and public roads.

The results of each race are evaluated using a points system to determine two annual World Championships: one for drivers, the other for constructors. Drivers must hold valid Super Licences, the highest class of racing licence issued by the FIA. The races are required to be held on tracks graded "1" (formerly "A"), the highest grade rating issued by the FIA.[2] Most events are held in rural locations on purpose-built tracks, but there are several events in city centres throughout the world, with the Monaco Grand Prix being the most well-known.[citation needed]

Formula One cars are the fastest regulated road course racing cars in the world, owing to very high cornering speeds achieved through the generation of large amounts of aerodynamic downforce. The cars underwent major changes in 2017, allowing wider front and rear wings, and wider tyres, resulting in cornering forces closing in on 6.5g and top speeds of up to approximately 375 km/h (235 mph). The hybrid engines are currently limited in performance to a maximum of 15,000 rpm and the cars are very dependent on electronics—although traction control and other driving aids have been banned since 2008—and also on aerodynamics, suspension, and tyres.

While Europe is the sport's traditional base, the championship is truly global, with 11 of the 21 races in the 2018 season taking place outside Europe. With the annual cost of running a mid-tier team—designing, building, and maintaining cars, pay, transport—being US\$120 million, Formula One has a significant economic and job-creation effect, and its financial and political battles are widely reported. Its high profile and popularity have created a major merchandising environment, which has resulted in large investments from sponsors and budgets (in the hundreds of millions for the constructors). On 8 September 2016, it was announced that Liberty Media had agreed to buy Delta Topco, the company that controls Formula One, from private equity firm CVC Capital Partners for \$4.4 billion in cash, stock, and convertible debt. On 23 January 2017, it was confirmed that the acquisition had been completed, for \$8 billion.

Spelunky

A 2D platformer with critically acclaimed reviews



Development

Spelunky is a 2008 source-available indie 2D platform video game created by Derek Yu and released as freeware for Microsoft Windows. It was remade for the Xbox 360 in 2012, with ports of the new version to the PlayStation 3 and PlayStation Vita in 2013, which was also ported back to Microsoft Windows. Spelunky is one of the first games that borrowed concepts from roguelikes and combined them with real-time side-scrolling platformer elements. Due to its popularity, it was the influence for many later "rogue-lite" games.

Gameplay

The player controls a spelunker who explores a series of caves while collecting treasure, saving damsels, fighting enemies, and dodging traps. The caves are procedurally generated, making each run through of the game unique. The spelunker can whip or jump on enemies to defeat them, pick up items that can be thrown to either attack enemies or set off traps, and use a limited supply of bombs and ropes to navigate the caves. Levels are randomly generated and grouped into four increasingly difficult "areas", each with a distinctive set of items, enemies, terrain types and special features. If the player loses all their hearts or runs into a deadly trap, they will have to start from the beginning.

Sequel

Derek Yu returned to develop the sequel. According to him, as he reflected on the development of the first game when he was writing a book about it for Boss Fight Books, he began to have more and more ideas for the sequel. He partnered with BlitWorks, the developer of the PlayStation ports of the first game, for the game's programming Yu needed to outsource the game's development to BlitWorks because of the sequel's larger scope. Yu intentionally ensured that the game would not be radically different from the first Spelunky as he felt that sequels should be "extensions of the previous games", and that fans of the first game would feel like they are playing a "continuation". New features were added to the game, while the original gameplay loop was refined and remixed.

WHO ARE GORILLAZ?

Gorillaz are a British virtual band created in 1998 by musician Damon Albarn and artist Jamie Hewlett. The band primarily consists of four animated members: Stuart "2-D" Pot, Murdoc Niccals, Noodle, and Russel Hobbs. Their fictional universe is presented in music videos, interviews and short cartoons. In reality, Albarn is the only permanent musical contributor, and Gorillaz' music often features collaborations with a wide range of featured artists. Remi Kabaka Jr. became producer for the band in 2016 after several years providing the voice of Russel Hobbs and was listed as an official member alongside Albarn and Hewlett in the 2019 documentary Gorillaz: Reject False Icons.

WHAT IS THEIR STORY?

With Gorillaz, Albarn departed from the distinct Britpop of his band Blur, exploring a variety of musical styles including hip hop, electronic music, and world music through an "eccentrically postmodern" approach. The band's 2001 debut album Gorillaz, which featured dub and Latin influences, went triple platinum in the UK and double platinum in Europe, with sales driven by the success of the album's lead single "Clint Eastwood". Their second studio album, Demon Days (2005), went 6 times platinum in the UK and double platinum in the US and spawned the successful lead single "Feel Good Inc."

WHAT IS SONG MACHINE?

Song Machine is an audiovisual project by British virtual band Gorillaz. It is a music-based web series consisting of a collection of standalone singles and music videos that are released monthly as episodes of the series, with each episode featuring additional guests. Each episode is released with accompanying interludes called Machine Bitez, a series of skits consisting of short conversations and interviews with Song Machine's guests from Gorillaz' virtual band members. The project was officially launched on 30 January 2020. Season one of Song Machine is set to consist of 11 episodes and was released as an album titled Song Machine, Season One: Strange Timez on 23 October 2020.

UP COMING SEASONS OF THE FLASH

Ever since The Flash first debuted in 2014, each new season has started in the first or second week of October. This season will be different, however – with The CW confirming that lockdown-related production delays ended up pushing the premiere to January 2021. The good news is, according to The Flash's showrunner Eric Wallace, the lockdown's impact on filming will make season seven "even better": "I think it's making it stronger because it's forcing us to look at these two separate things – which is the end of Eva's story and the beginning of the next villain's story and how she relates to Barry and Iris." Explaining that season seven will pick up immediately where the impromptu season six finale ended, Wallace said that 90% of the footage for its first three episodes is "in the can". "That only leaves what we always intended as our two-part season finale of season six to follow in [season seven's first two episodes], which is wrapping up Eva's story. That's all going to be the same," he said. "They kind of have to be connected even more because there isn't some summer break anymore. The audience will experience it now a week later."



Right now, it's hard to specify what will happen in The Flash season seven, but it's likely that the show may soon come to an end. If so, this will undoubtedly impact the story moving forward. I mean, we're all contracted right now [for] seven seasons – this is the sixth, so it's definitely in the back of my mind that next year, even, could be potentially the last season. Who knows?
